BAD NEWS, Last fall we were notified that the fireworks company we had been using for many years closed and went out of business.

GOOD NEWS, our fireworks show was put out to bid, with specs supplied by our previous vendor. Three companies were interviewed, and two made the cut. We have contracted with Pyrotechnics, which is an Indiana company that provided the show on top of Fiserv Forum, when the Milwaukee Bucks won the finals last year. The fireworks committee has worked very hard on this and is now very excited about the change and feel that it will be an upgrade from last year. Costs have escalated, so we are again counting on everyone's support for this great event.
